The Pyramids of Giza are one of the most **spectacular** World Heritage sites in the world. They are also one of the most famous. They get around 14 million visitors each year. The pyramids are located on the west bank of The Nile River in Cairo, Egypt. Here are three reasons why I would like to visit these pyramids one day.

First, if you visit The Pyramids, you can travel into the past. The pyramids were built over 4,500 years ago! They were built as **tombs** for Egyptian kings. The Great Pyramid took over 20 years to build. Thousands of Egyptian men worked **endlessly** to **complete** it. I want to see what humans could build so long ago.

Second, The Great Pyramid of Giza is **enormous**! It is 146 meters high. It was the highest man-made building for 3,800 years. Now, the pyramids are slowly **shrinking**. I hope I can visit them before they get any smaller.

Finally, I want to take a cruise down the longest river in the world, The Nile River. You can see many other Egyptian pyramids and temples on the cruise. You can also visit the tombs of Pharaohs, Egyptian kings. I want to visit The Egyptian Pyramids and imagine what life was like so long ago!

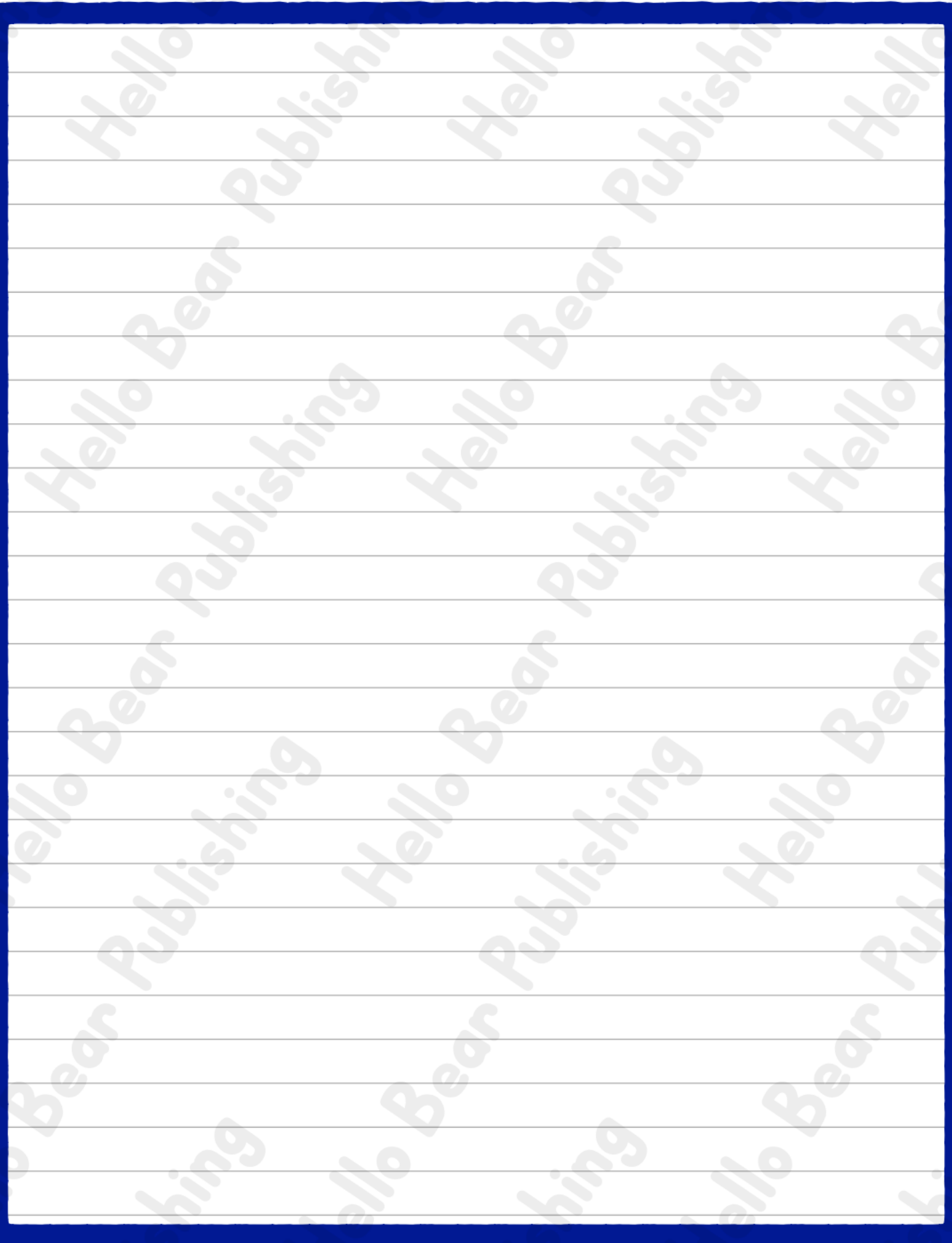

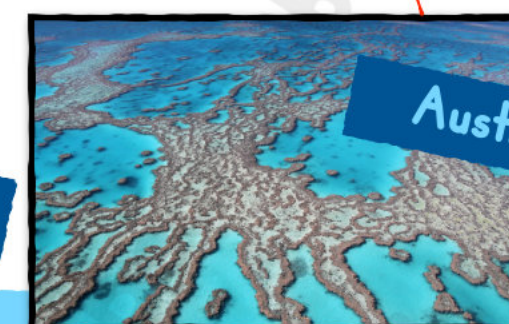
